<p>News Report</p> <p><u>New Brighton Footballer Killed</u></p> <p>Lieut. Henry R. Morgan, Duke of Lancaster's Own Yeomanry, attached to the Royal Flying Corps, was killed in action on November 8. He was 28 years of age and formerly in the Denbighshire Yeomanry. He has been two years in France. He was educated at Liscard High School, and was in the Manager's Office of the Liverpool Tramway Co. He played for New Brighton Rugby Club, and attended Rowson Street Wesleyan Church. He was the only son of Mrs. Morgan, and the late Mr. E.R. Morgan, 'Orrisdale,' Sandheys Road, Liscard.</p> <p>Major B.E. Sutton writes:- - "Dear Mrs. Morgan.- It is with very deep regret that I have to report to you the death of your son in action, November 8. I have known him long enough, and there needed no long time to appreciate the force of his example and his attractive personality. You have the sympathy of the entire squadron, who lost in him a friend of great character, and a very capable officer. It may be of some comfort to you to know that the machine he was on was so hit that his death would have been instantaneous."</p>
