News Report

Ship Officer Drowned

There were laid to rest on Saturday at Rake Lane Cemetery, the remains of Chief Petty Officer Peter Francis Morgan, who lost his life at sea on September 19th, through the torpedoing of s.s ----- . He was last seen sitting on an improvised raft, having thrown a life buoy to a fireman, telling him to save himself. The late Mr Morgan, who was 26 years of age, leaves a widow and baby to mourn his loss, who reside at 62, Wright Street, Egremont.

Prior to the interment Requiem Mass was celebrated at St. Alban's Church, Liscard, by the Rev. Canon Walsh, who also performed the last rites at the cemetery. The coffin was draped with the Union Jack, and borne to the graveside by six Quartermasters of the Harrison Line.
