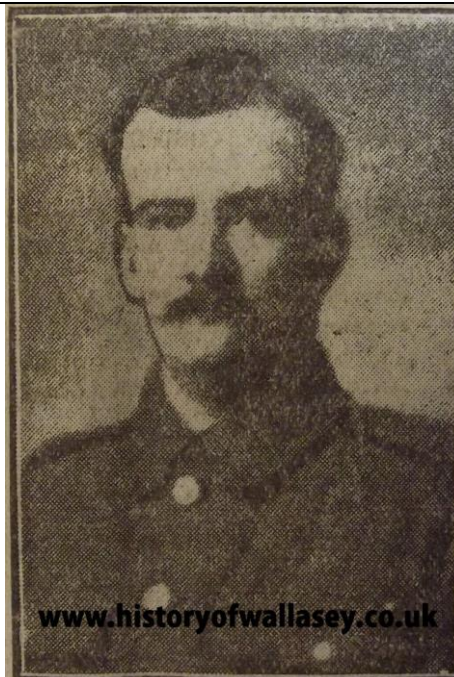

Private George Morley, Scottish Rifles, who at one time resided at 8 Rappart Road, Seacombe, has fallen in action.
