#### Died From Wounds

Mr. J.W. Morris, of 33, Edgmond Street, Seacombe, has received the sad intelligence that his second son, Private John William Morris, was wounded on July 23, and died the same day at the Field Ambulance, France. He was 20 years of age, and enlisted in the Cheshire Regt., in August 1915. He was drafted to Egypt, and from there was sent to France, where he had only been three weeks. He attended St. Paul's Church, Seacombe, and was formerly in the employ of Mr. W. Lavin, Egremont. Two other brothers are serving with the colours, one in the Navy, and the other in France.
