#### Education Clerk Killed

The sad intelligence has been officially received that Pte. Charles Herbert (Bert) Neale, K.L.R., was killed in action on August 31<sup>st</sup>. He was 32 years of age and joined up on November 7, 1914, and was drafted to France in February, 1915.

Previous to enlistment he was employed in the Liverpool Education Office for 17 years, and was the eldest son of Mr and Mrs Charles E. Neale, "Rostrevor," Holland Road, Liscard. He attended New Bright Wesleyan Church.
