Died Of Wounds

The sad intimation has been received that Pte. Stanley Nelson, South Wales Borderers, died from wounds on August 25, at Brooks' Military Hospital, Woolwich. He joined the Army in Mat, 1915, and had been in France over two years.

He had been three times wounded. He was educated at Somerville Council School, and was the only son of Mrs. A.N. Nelson, and of the late Mr. Fred Nelson, 11, Palermo Street, Seacombe.
