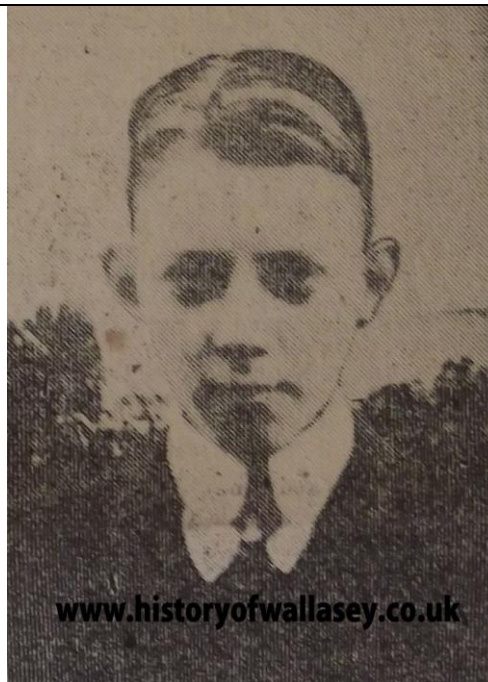

Liscard Soldier Killed

Official intimation has been received by Mr and Mrs B. Newport, of 17, Radnor Drive, Liscard, that their son, Benjamin Franklin Newport, of the South Wales Borderers. Was killed in action on August 27th. The young soldier was educated at the Limes School, Shrewsbury, and finished his education at Wallasey Grammar School. He was employed in the clerical department of the Liverpool General Accident Insurance Company, was a member of St. Columbia Choir, and a Sunday School teacher.
