<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>A Tragic Coincidence</u></p> <p><u>Well Known Athlete's Death</u></p> <p>Mr and Mrs Frank Nichol, of 14, Claughton Drive, Poulton, have received notification of the death of their only son, Lance-Sergeant Sidney Frank Nichol, of the King's Liverpool Regiment. An old boy of Birchfield School and an employee of the Prudential Assurance Co., he was also keen local athlete, being connected with the Egremont St. John's Cricket Club, and the Oakdale Mission Swimming Club. In a championship race held several years ago in connection with the latter club Nichol finished second, between Sidney Adams (Liverpool Scottish) the winner, and Harry Burgess, third. All three men have since been killed in action.</p>
