<p>Sergt. George Nichols. Of the Cheshire Regiment, 51 Mount Pleasant Road, New Brighton, has been killed in France. He joined the Army in October, 1914, and had thus served for four years before meeting his death on October 2nd, at the age of 23 years. He was an old boy of the Vaughan Road Schools, and attended the Liscard Congregational Church Mission. He was also a Good Templar. A fortnight before his death he was made a sergeant.</p>
