<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Wirral Railway Employee Killed</u></p> <p>Official intimation has been received that Private James Henry Oliphant, Cheshire Regiment, was killed in action on November 6. He had been in the Army three years, and was drafted to Palestine some 20 months ago. He was 21 years of age, and was educated at St. George's Road Council School, Wallasey, and was formerly employed with the Wirral Railway Co. Music was his special hobby. He was the youngest son of Mr and Mrs Fred Oliphant, 7, Granville Terrace, Wallasey. Another son is in Salonica, and has been three times wounded.</p>
