Forty years of age, he joined the Army over two years ago, and had served 15 months in France. He was formerly employed at the Anglo-American Oil Company. He was the eldest son of Mrs. Parry, and of the late Mr. John Parry, 1, Oakdale Road, Seacombe. His brother was killed in action, July 1916, and another brother is serving in France,</p>
