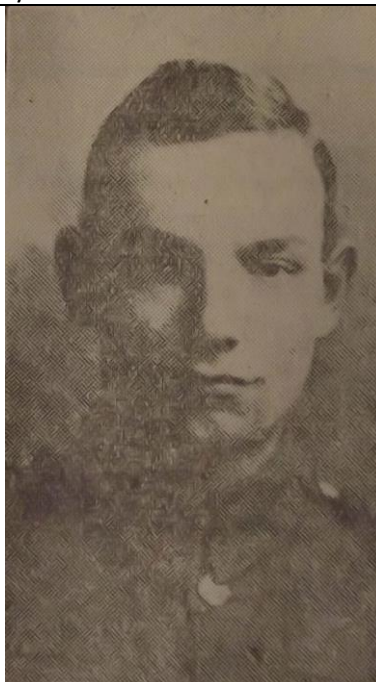

News Report

Died From Shell Wounds

An official telegram has been received conveying the sad news that Corporal Robert (Bob) Henry Parry, 8th Field Ambulance, died from shell wounds in the legs and arms, on October 28th. Only 20 years of age, he joined the 4th King's Shropshire Light Infantry, in May, 1917, and was transferred to the South Wales Borderers before proceeding to France last January and became attached to the 7th K.S.L.I. The brave soldier was severely wounded in March last. He was an old Taunton Schoolboy, and previous to enlistment was a Custom's clerk. A good all-round athlete he was the only son of Mrs Catherine Parry, 208, Rake Lane, Liscard, and of the late Mr Robert Henry Parry, G.P.O., Liverpool.
