Another Footballer Killed

The first member of the Glendale Football Club to fall is Rifleman Richard Peet, of the Rifle Brigade, who was killed in action on September 18th. In the employ of Mr. T.W. Weale, the Egremont painter and decorator, deceased was a well-known figure in the district, especially in football circles. Although not a regular player in the Glendale side, he could nevertheless invariably be relied upon to act as a good utility man. Rifleman Peet had been out in France since July, 1915, and previous to enlistment in November, 1914, he resided at 41, Edith Road, Seacombe.
