#### News Report

##### Seacombe Postman Killed

Private Edward Plant, of the Royal Welsh Fusiliers, has been posted as killed in action between July 31 and August 4. He joined up on June 5, 1816, and was drafted to France in September. He had been a postman in Seacombe for 14 years, and was a member of the Wallasey Harriers. His wife and two children reside at 57, Gladstone Road, Seacombe. His brother, [William Plant](#), was killed in action twelve months ago. Another brother is in the Army, and one in the Navy.
