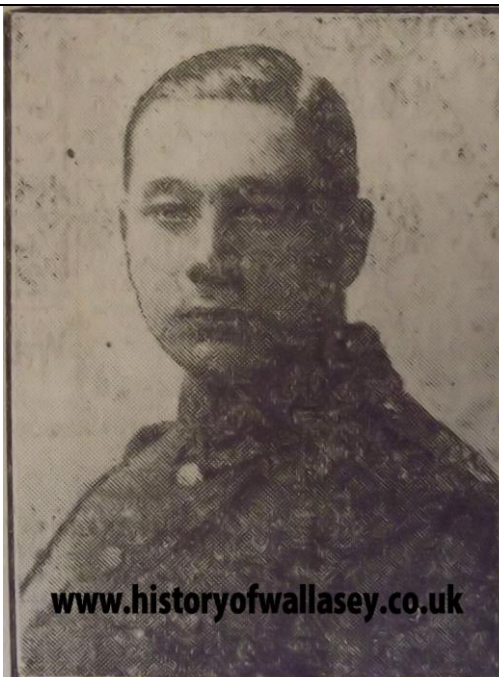

Seacombe Soldier Killed

Mr and Mrs C.J. Platt, of 3, Trentham Road, Seacombe, have received the sad news that Pte. Charles John (Rodge) Platt, Cheshire Regt., was killed in action on September 2. He joined the colours in February, 1917, and went to Italy, and was drafted to France last April. He was educated at Bootle Technical School, and was formerly employed as clerk with Messrs. Staveley, Taylor, and Co., shipping insurance agents, Liverpool. He attended St. Paul's Church, and was a member of the Vicar's Bible Class. He was 20 years of age.
