News Report

Council Employee Killed By A Shell

We regret to record the death of Private James Price, Lancashire Fusiliers, who was killed by a shell on December 4th. The gallant soldier was one of a party of six watching the front line when a shell burst behind him, killing him almost instantly. His wife, Mrs. Price, of 69, Silverlea Avenue, Liscard, has received a letter from Captain A. Hesling, in which he said that the deceased "was a good soldier, and died at his post keeping watch whilst others worked and rested." Private Price was 29 years of age, and worked in the Gas Department of the Wallasey Corporation.
