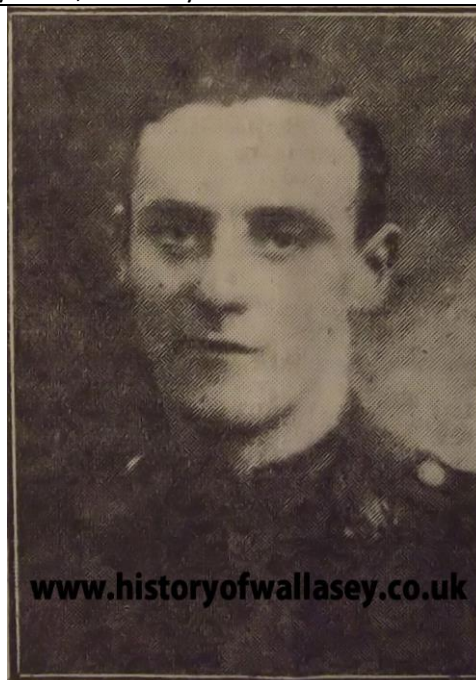

#### News Report

##### Died From Wounds

The sad information has been received of the death from wounds of Private John Daniel Pritchard, 7<sup>th</sup> Royal Fusiliers, which occurred on November 9<sup>th</sup>, at a Casualty Clearing Station. He was 32 years of age, and joined the Colours on October 12<sup>th</sup>, 1914. He was engaged for some time in training horses. He had only been a fortnight in France when he was wounded. Private Pritchard was well-known as a Conductor in the service of the Wallasey Corporation Tramways. He was the youngest son of the late Mr and Mrs James Pritchard, 16, Wallasey Road, and his wife, with three young children, reside at 19, Silverlea Avenue, Seaview Road, Liscard.
