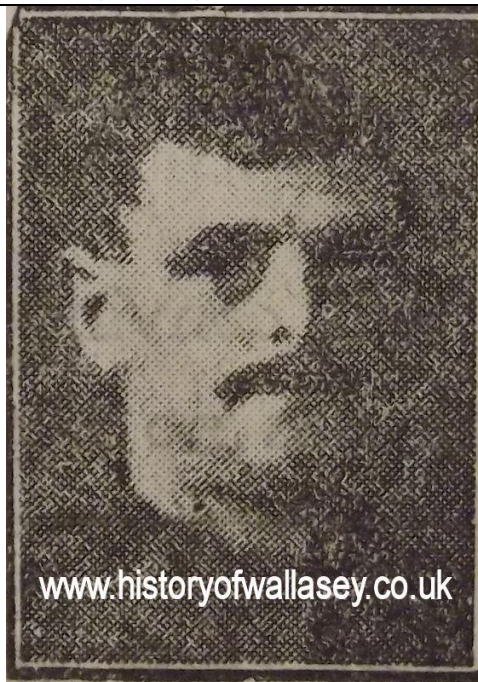

News Report

Killed By A Shell

The sad news has been received that Private Peter Prowse, whose wife and three children live at 64, Silverton Avenue, Liscard, has been killed in action in France. One of the deceased's soldier's comrades in a letter to Mrs. Prowse said he had been asked by the members of the Company to express their sympathy with her at the death of her husband, which they all greatly deplored. He was advancing with the rest of the company in an attack on the Germans on October 9 when a shell fell amongst them, killing him instantaneously. Private Prowse, who was 35 years of age, was in the Lancashire Fusiliers, and had been at the front eight months. Prior to enlisting he had been in the employ of Messrs. Barker and Jones, of Leasowe Road, for 14 years.
