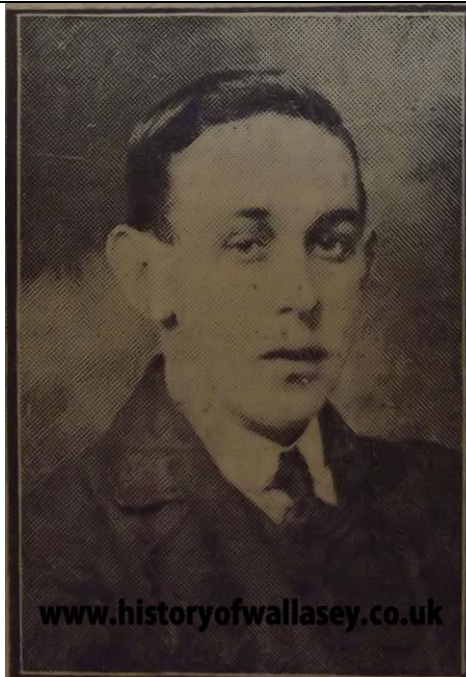

#### News Report

##### Liscard Soldier Killed

News has been received by his parents at Liscard of the death of Private Rawlinson, of 16, Kimberley Road. Private Rawlinson, who was 23 years of age, was reported missing in October, but it has since transpired that he fell in action on Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>, in Belgium. The young fellow, who was well known, and had many friends in Wallasey and Birkenhead, was for five years employed at Messrs. Lever Bros., at Port Sunlight. He was called up on the special reserves of the Cheshires, and served in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion.
