#### Egremont Soldier Killed [August 1917]

Pte. Leslie Riches, of the Cheshire Regt., was reported in the "Wallasey News" as "missing since November 13, 1916. Official intimation has been received that he was killed in action. He was educated at St. Margaret's School, Anfield, Liverpool, and was in the cycling business. He was the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. John Riches, 20, Hothfield Road, Egremont.
