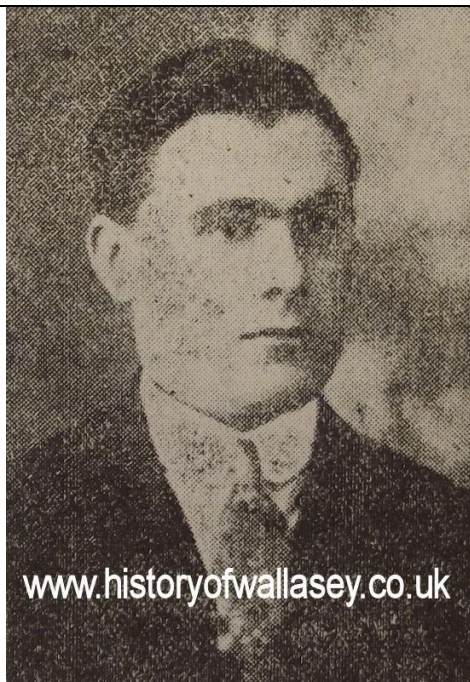

Died Of Wounds

Corpl. Walter Riley, of the Royal Welsh Fusiliers, died from wounds received in action on October 29, at the Canadian Hospital, Etypes. He was 26 years of age, and joined up at the beginning of last year. He had been three months in France. He was educated at Riverside Council School, and was formerly employed as clerk with Mr. T.W.Weale, 40, Church Street, Egremont. He was the youngest son of Mrs. M.J. Riley, and of the late Mr. Joseph Riley, 88, Bell Road, Seacombe (late of Gladstone Road). His wife, who resides at Edge Lane, Liverpool, is left with twins (boy and a girl) twelve months old.
