Cotton Clerk Killed

Mr and Mrs John C. Roberts, 9, Elmswood Road, Egremont, have received the sad intelligence that their fifth son, Pte. Arthur Ernest Roberts, Royal Lancaster Regt. (late of the K.L.R.) was killed in action on April 13. He enlisted on Oct. 30, 1915, and was drafted to France in July, 1916. He was educated at the College, Shaw Street, Liverpool, and was a clerk with Messrs. Miller, Beer, and Co., cotton brokers, Liverpool, and attended St. George's Church, Everton. Three other sons are serving with the colours.
