<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Lewis Gunner Killed</u></p> <p>The sad news of the death of their son, Private James Noel Roberts, Royal Welsh Fusiliers, has been received by Mr and Mrs J.S. Roberts, of 9 Ponsonby Road, Wallasey. He enlisted in November, 1916, and went to France the following July after training on the East Coast. He was wounded shortly after his arrival in France, and subsequently fought against the great German advance last March. At the time of his death on the 26th August he was engaged on a Lewis gun. Prior to joining the colours he was in the service of Messrs. F.W. Roggen & Co., hide merchants, of Castle Street, Liverpool. Private Roberts' older brother, Mr H.P. Roberts, who is now discharged, was in the Royal Naval Division, and was wounded at Beaumont Hamel in February, 1917, being the only survivor of a group of six men.</p>
