#### News Report

##### Liscard Officer Succumbs

Mr and Mrs W.H. Robertson, 3, Earlston Road, Liscard, have been notified that their elder son, 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut. Herbert Neville Robertson, died from wounds on April 30, received in action on April 14, at the General Hospital, Treport. He was 23 years of age, joined the K.L.R. in September, 1914, and was drafted to France on February 21, 1915. He was sent home for his commission last May and gazetted to the Cheshire Regt., and went to France on January 14. He was interred with full military honours in the British Military Cemetery. His only brother is serving with the colours.
