On the outbreak of war he joined the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion of the Australian contingent, which landed in Egypt towards the end of last year, subsequently proceeding to the Dardanelles. He was 23 years of age, and much sympathy will be extended to his parents on the loss of a promising son.
