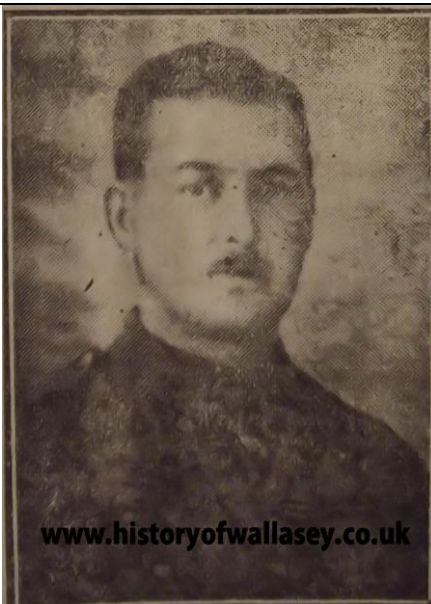

News Report

Wallasey Bowler Killed

The sad intelligence has been received by Mrs. B. Shaw, of 19, Hillcroft Road, Wallasey, that her husband, Pte. Francis Ormsby Shaw, King's Shropshire Light Infantry, has been killed in action. He joined the Army in May, 1917, and was drafted to Egypt on October, and after serving there until last March he was sent to France. Thirty-eight years of age, he was educated at Salisbury College, Liverpool, and for 22 years was employed as under surveyor with Messrs. Brorick, Leach and Kendal, shipping insurance agents, Exchange Flags, Liverpool. He was a keen bowler, and was often seen playing on the Central Park green, Liscard. His widow is left with four children.
