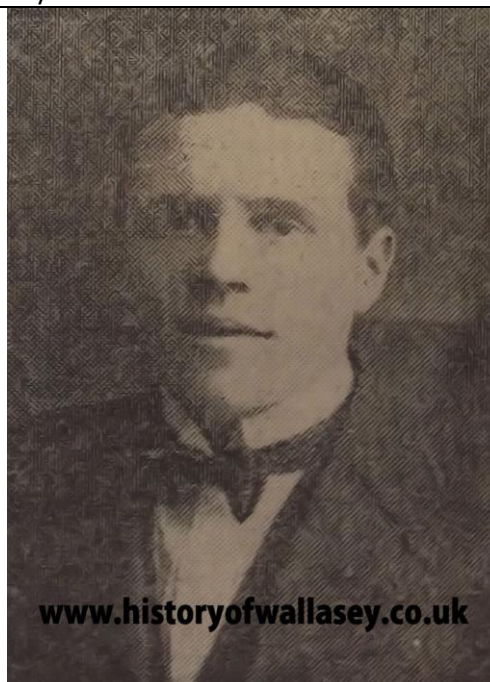

News Report

Killed On Hill 60

It is with regret that we record the death of Alex P. Sheridan, the son of Mr. Michael J. Sheridan, of Wallasey. The young man was well-known throughout the Wallasey district, and was a great favourite by reason of his cheery and happy nature. He was a prominent member of the Warren Gold Club, and joined the 6th Battalion of the King's (Liverpool) Regt., at the outbreak of the war. In a letter from a friend, which his parents have received, the writer gives an account of the young fellow's death. "We were advancing," he said, "across a field when he was shot. The bullet went right through his heart, and is supposed to have hit the chap behind him. I was third in order, and saw poor Alex, drop. I stopped and did all I could do for him. He, poor fellow, just gave a few groans, and all was over in a few seconds. He was in my arms when he passed into God's keeping."
