Another New Brighton Loss

Another New Brightonian to pay the supreme sacrifice is Private George Winstanley Slee (King's Liverpool Regiment), of 29, Fort Street, who was killed in action on October 12th. Twenty-three years of age, he enlisted in March, 1915, and had been at the front since December last. An enthusiastic member of St. John's Church, Egremont, the deceased was also prominently associated with the Clifton Parliamentary Debating Society.
