Poulton Soldier Torpedoed

Mrs. Smallman, of 22, Rosalind Street, Poulton, has received the sad news that her husband, Pte. James Smallman was drowned on May 4, on his voyage to Egypt. Twenty-nine years of age, he joined the King's Liverpool Regiment on June 5, 1916, and was transferred to the Loyal North Lancashire Regt. He was drafted to France on the 17th April last, and sailed on May 2. He was formerly employed by the Vacuum Oil Co., Birkenhead, and leaves a widow and one child to mourn his loss.
