Old Grammar School Boy

Lance-Corporal Avard Forsyth Smith, who resided with his mother at 9 Maldwyn Road, Liscard, died recently from wounds in Cumberwell Hospital, where he had been brought from France. An old Grammar School boy, the deceased soldier was 22 years of age, and had been in the Army three years. Joining the King's Liverpool Rifles, he was afterwards transferred to the Liverpool Regiment, with whom he served in France. He was a Lewis gunner and a bomber, and had recently been gas corporal. In civil life he was on the staff of the Royal Insurance Co. He was also well-known as a member of Seacombe Congregational Church.
