<p>Chronicle News</p> <p>The funeral of Lieut. D. MacQuistan Smith, R.A.F., took place at St. Nicholas Cemetery, Lincoln, on August 24th. This officer was only 19 years of age, and was the eldest son of Mr and Mrs Perry Smith, of Parkstone, Dorset, and formerly of Wallasey. The late Lieutenant Smith died five weeks after an accident whilst flying on military duty. After being invalided from France, he became a flying pilot, and was doing useful work. He was considered an exceptionally clever pilot. He was educated at the Wallasey Grammar School and Ellesmere College.</p>
