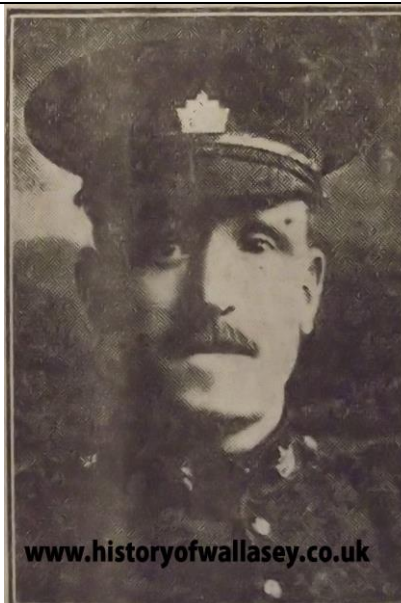

##### Local Canadian Killed

Private James Joseph Smith, Canadian Regiment, was killed in action on October 1. He enlisted at the outbreak of the war, and was drafted to France on March 5, 1915. He was the third son of the late William Boyle and Isabella P. Smith, and resided with his sister at "Halki," 41, Clarendon Road, Egremont.
