News Report

Liscard Sergeant Killed

The sad intelligence has reached Mr and Mrs Smith, 6, Pear Tree Grove, Liscard, that their second son Sergt. William Smith, Cheshire Regiment died on October 15th, from wounds received in action. Sergt. Smith, who joined up on the outbreak of war, was formerly employed at Palmerston and Co., Liscard, and was a regular attender at Wesley Hall, Liscard. He had seen service with regiment at Gallipoli, and in Palestine, entering Jerusalem with General Allenby's victorious forces. In these series of engagements he was twice wounded. After leaving Palestine, the regiment was drafted to France some 3 months ago and shortly after he was granted leave home. The first since leaving England. Returning to the French front about 7 weeks ago, he met his death shortly afterwards, both legs having been so dreadfully and wounded, that it was impossible to save him.
