Egremont Steward's Death

Mr. Leslie Allan Stanfield, a second-class steward on the Lusitania, who was amongst the victims, was a son of Mr and Mrs Thomas Stanfield, of 1, Wright Street, Egremont. He had been on the Lusitania since her maiden trip, and also on the Aquitania on the occasion of her first voyage to New York. Mr. W. Ross, another steward, who belongs to Lancaster, resided with Mr. and Mrs Stanfield, and he was amongst the survivors. Although he was prostrated by the terrible experience he had gone through, he has since been able to proceed to Lancaster. Mr. Stanfield is in ill-health, and has suffered so severely from the loss of his son and that the worst is feared.
