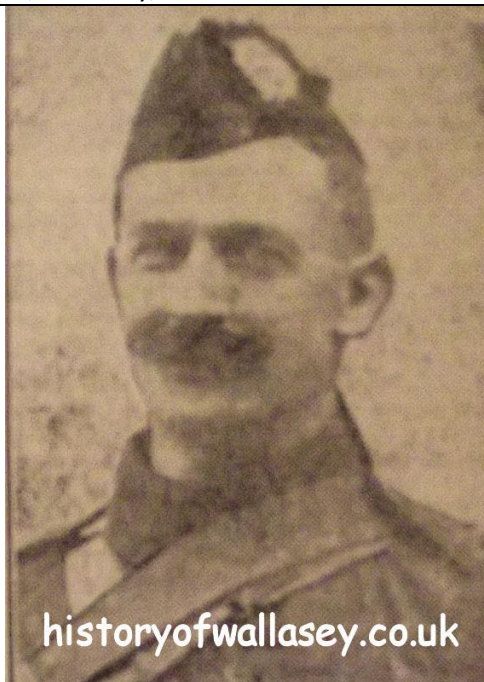

News Report

Seacombe Quarter-Master-Sergt. Dies of Wounds

The sad intelligence has been received by Mrs. Stoddart, 24, York Road, Seacombe, that her husband, Regt.-Quarter-Master-Sergt. James Stoddart, of the King's Liverpool Regt, died from wounds on August 2. The gallant soldier was one of the originators of the Liverpool Scottish, and had resided in Wallasey for 13 years. He was a deacon of Stanley Masonic Lodge (No. 1325), and went to France as Pipe-Major of the Battalion. He was afterwards raised to the rank of Quartermaster-Sergt. His son, John S. Stoddart, has succeeded his father as Pipe-Major. Another son is also serving in France.
