#### Liscard Engineer Dies From Exposure

We regret to announce that Fourth Engineer Gilbert Stott died from exposure, though the torpedoing of the steamship ----- . He was 29 years of age and educated at the Merchant Taylors School, Great Crosby. At the beginning of the war he joined the Special Service Squadron, R.R.R. He was a keen hockey player for the Sefton Club, Mr. Stott was the only son of the late Mr James Stott, Great Crosby, and of Mrs. Stott, 6, Stretton Street, Liscard.
