News Report

Died From Wounds

Intimation has been received that Pte. Wade Stubbs, aged 22 years, died from wounds in France on April 14. He joined the Territorials (Cheshire Regt.) in 1913, and was called up at the outbreak of the war, when he was transferred to the Gloucester Regt., and had been over two years in France. He was educated at St. Margaret's School, Anfield, Liverpool, was a clerk with Messrs. A.B. Dalzell and Co., Liverpool. He was for nine years a member of St. Margaret's choir with his brother, and was afterwards a member of St. John's Church, Egremont, and the Rev. J.T. Vale's Bible Class. He was previously wounded twelve months ago, and the eldest son of Mrs. Emily Stubbs, 28, Walsingham Road, Wallasey.
