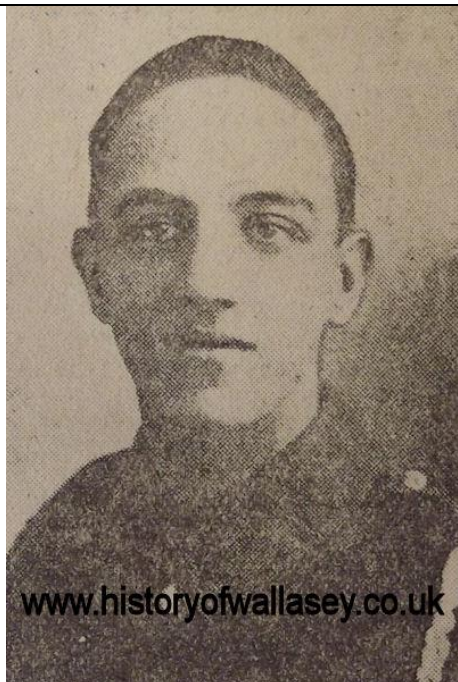

Signaller John P. Sumner, of the Cheshire Regt., was reported missing and is now reported as wounded. He is in his 20th year, and any news concerning him will be gratefully received by his mother, Mrs. L. Sumner, 53, Park Road, Seacombe.

Seacombe Signaller Killed

In last Saturday's "Wallasey News" we asked for information concerning Signaller John Platt Sumner, of the Cheshire Regt., who was reported "missing." His mother, who resides at 53, Park Road, Seacombe, has now received official intimation that her brave son was killed in action on June 7.

The Chaplain commanding writes:- "He was a real good fellow, and a very

capable signaller, always willing to do his work, and one of the first to volunteer for extra tricky jobs. I wish you to accept my deepest sympathy – his fellow signallers and myself are all very sorry to lose him.
