Local Footballer Killed

News of the death of another Wallasey Corporation employee and a well-known footballer, in the person of Private J.G. Taker, of the Queen's Royal Surry Regiment, has been received by his wife at 42, Pleasant Street, New Brighton.

The deceased, who was 33 years of age, had been in the employ of the tramway department for some fourteen years. He enlisted in February and was drafted to the front six months ago. Apparently he was wounded by a bullet a little time back for the official communication states that he died from wounds.
