News Report

Council Employee Killed

A report has been received through the Swiss Red Cross that Corpl. Harry O. Tate, a former member of the Town Clerk's staff, who has been missing since the German offensive in March, has been killed in action. Corpl. Tate, who was the only son of Mrs. Tate and the late Captain Tate, of Wallasey, was a sergeant in the 4th Cheshires at the outbreak of the war, and joined up with the Territorials. He had been in France since last January. Corpl. Tate was very popular with his colleagues in the Town Clerk's department where he had been employed for about eight years, and the announcement of his death has been received with great regret.
