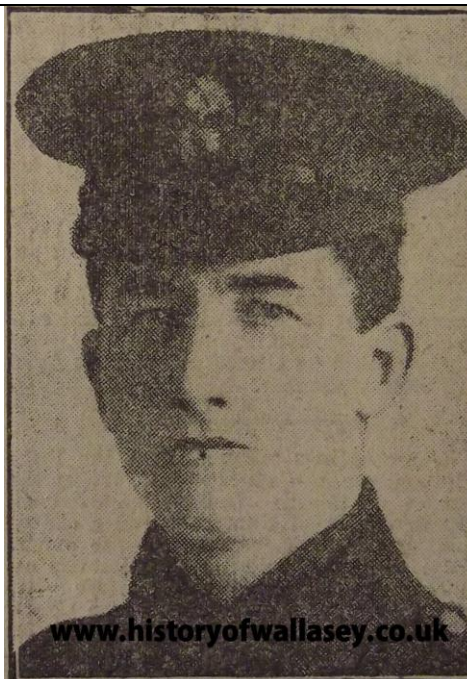

#### News Report

##### Wallasey Guardsman Killed

Early in October, Mrs. Titley, of 96, Deveraux Drive, Wallasey, received official notification that her only son, Private Edward Titley, of the Grenadier Guards, had been wounded in action. On the 11<sup>th</sup> of this month Mrs, Titley received further official notification saying that her son was killed in action between the 14<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> of September. Private Titley was an old Wallaseyan, and passed his final examination for the Custom and Excise prior to joining the colours. He attended the Seacombe Congregational Church and was a member of the Sunday School.
