Mr. T. Trickett, of 23, Evelyn Road, Wallasey, has received official notice that his eldest son, Norman V. Trickett, aged 20 years, machine gun section, is posted as missing after the engagement of July 7th last. He joined the Wallasey Pals in August, 1914, and went to the front eleven months ago. As a boy he was a member of the St. John's Church Choir, and also took a great interest in the Boy Scout movements. Prior to joining, he was employed by Messrs. Bunnery's Ltd., Church Street, Liverpool. Any news of him would be gratefully received by his parents, Mr and Mrs T. Trickett. His younger brother is also in France with the Liverpool Pals.
