<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Death From Wounds</u></p> <p>In last Wednesday's <i>Chronicle</i> we recorded the fact that Mrs. Turnstall, of 15, Kenwyn Road, Liscard had been officially informed that her son, Private George Tunstall, of the King's Liverpool Regiment ("Pals"), had been wounded, and was lying in a base hospital. It is now our sad duty to relate that the young fellow has succumbed to his injuries.</p> <p>Private Tunstall, who was 20 years of age, was formerly employed in the purchase department of the Canadian Pacific Railway, Liverpool, and enlisted at the outbreak of hostilities. He had been wounded previously, as during the earlier portion of the year he was buried beneath the debris in the collapse of a dugout, along with a former member of our staff, who has also lost his life.</p>
