<u>Liscard Soldier Reported Killed</u>

Official intimation has been received from the War Office that Private John (Jack) Turner, of the King's Liverpool Regiment, was wounded in the Somme battle on April 13. Further news came to hand by letter on Wednesday that he was killed in action. He was educated at St. Francis Xavier's College, Liverpool, and was employed with Messrs. Muir, Duckworth and Co., cotton brokers, Liverpool. He joined the Army at the outbreak of the war, and had been in France since September of last year. He was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. H. T. Turner, "Lisbos", Grosvenor Street, Liscard.
