It will doubtlessly be recollected that he was temporarily invalided out of the ranks in July last, suffering from the effects of shell shock. The young man, who is a familiar figure in local sporting circles, was formerly captain of the Poulton Olympic Football Club in the Wallasey Invinsa League, and whilst setting in that capacity he frequently contributed to these columns under the pseudonym of "pot-shot." Indeed, Private Vincent was once successful in securing a fountain pen awarded in connection with one of our merit competitions. He was formerly employed by Messrs. J.H. Wilson and Co.</p>
