<p>Chronicle News</p> <p>Local soldier, Pte. Joseph Thomas Walker, Australian Forces, son of the late Mr John Walker and of Mrs E. Walker, of 38 Hartismere Road, Seacombe, died of pneumonia at the Town Hall Military Hospital, Seacombe, on the 10th November. He was on ten days' leave prior to returning to Australia with his battalion when he took ill, and succumbed a week later. He enlisted in Australia in February, 1915, and served in Egypt, Gallipoli (where he was wounded), and in France. He also saw service in the South African War. Before going to Australia Pte. Walker, who was 43 years of age, was employed in Wallasey as a carpenter. He was educated at the old Vernon's Schools, Trafalgar Road, and took a deep interest in yachting. The funeral took place at Anfield Cemetery on Thursday.</p>
