News Report

Private James Henry Ward was killed in action on May 11th. He was the third son of Mrs. Ann Ward and the late Hugh Ward, of 26, Tower Street, Liscard.

Lieutenant-Colonel J.M. Reeves, in a letter of condolence to Mrs. Ward writes :-
 "I am writing to tender you my sincere sympathy, and that of your son, Private J.H. Ward, the news of which it is my duty to convey to you. I trust that you and your family will find consolation in the knowledge that your son died for his country, than which to any life can be more noble. His company and the regiment mourn his loss. Your son fell in the trenches, bravely carrying out his duty. He was killed instantaneously, his end being quite painless."
