#### News Report

##### Local Freemason Killed

Official news has been received at 128, Earlston Road, Liscard, that Private John Henry Warren, of the Liverpool Pals, has been killed. Private Warren was the son of a well-known Liscard tradesman, and was formerly a member of the church choir of Wallasey Church and latterly with St. Thomas' Church choir. He was a Freemason, and was a member of the Broadsmith Lodge. He enlisted about September, 1914, and was drafted to France in November of 1915. On June 11<sup>th</sup> it was reported by one of his comrades that he came through the second engagement and was in the act of shaking a comrade by the hand when he was "sniped".

Private J.H. Warren was piccolo player in the Brigade Band of the Liverpool Pals.
