#### News Report

##### Wallasey Lieutenant Killed

Lieut. Fred Washington, M.C., was killed in action on August 22. He joined the Liverpool "Pals" at the commencement of hostilities and was immediately drafted to France. He was transferred to the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, and awarded the Military Cross at Cambrai for conspicuous bravery on the field. He was the youngest son of the late Mr and Mrs T.L. Washington, of Malta, and nephew of Major and Mrs. Turner, 17, Hamlet Road, Wallasey. The gallant officer was 23 years of age.
