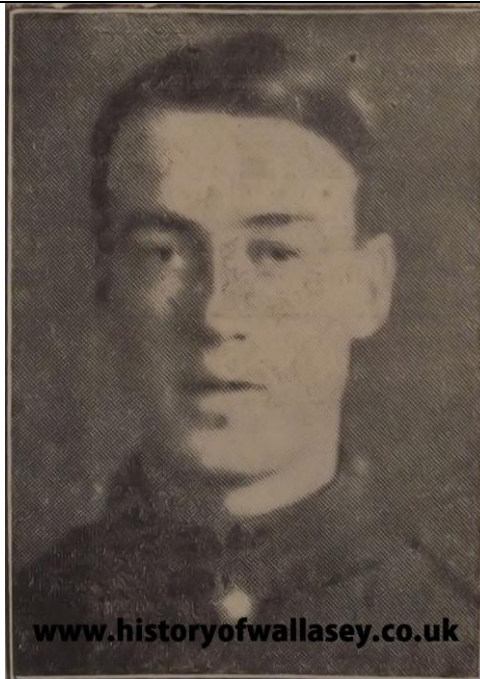

#### News Report

#### Seacombe Soldiers Death

Private George Welsh, 5, Byron Road, Seacombe, of the 11th King's Liverpool Regiment, died in a base hospital on June 13th of wounds received in action. An official communication was received on Wednesday, the intimation that he had died quickly following the news that he had been wounded.

Twenty-two years of age, Private Webb was in the pioneer section of the 11th King's, and prior to enlisting (in August) was employed on the gasworks extension in Dock Road. Sincere sympathy will be felt with his widowed mother, whose only son he was.
